### PROJECT DESCRIPTION



Recognizing the alarming rise of online hate and its devastating impact, the EMNHS LGBTQI project employs an innovative approach combining non-formal education, digital technologies, and intercultural dialogue. Activities include research, intervention protocol development, open-access resource creation, local youth assemblies, and online campaigns. The goal: equip youth workers and young people with the skills to counteract hate speech and promote human rights.
